1 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) Candidates seeking admission to LL.M Degree under Semester Scheme should have passed the LL.B degree of the Bangalore University or any other UGC recognized Universities and should have secured 45% in the aggregate of 3year/5year LL.B Degree Examination (5% relaxation for SC/St, Cat-I and Persons with disabilities candidates).
- b) There shall be a Common Entrance Test (CET) for all the eligible candidates for admission to the course as specified below.
- c) Merit List of the candidates shall be prepared by the admission committee based on the following criteria:
 - 1. 50% of the marks secured by the candidate in the CET and,
 - 2. 50% of the marks obtained in LL.B degree 3/5 year course in the aggregate.
 - No candidate otherwise eligible for admission shall be admitted if he/she fails to attend the CET and the counseling on the notified dates.
 - No student shall be permitted to pursue any other course of study leading to any other degree while he/she is pursuing LL.M course.

II INTAKE FOR THE COURSE

The number of candidates to be admitted to the Two Year Post-Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M – Semester Scheme) shall be 10 (Regular Seats) and 2 (Self finance Seats) in the following branches of specialization:

- 1. Constitution and Legal Order
- 2. Corporate and Commercial Law
- 3. Labour and Employment Law
- 4. Criminal Law

III RESERVATION OF SEATS

The admission of the candidates shall be based on merit cum reservation policy of the State Government/Rules of Bangalore University with regard to Supernummary seats issued from time to time.

A foreign student from other than English speaking countries seeking admission to Two Year Post Graduate Degree Programme in Law (LL.M-Semester Scheme) shall have completed the TOEFEL or other equivalent exam from fulfilling the minimum eligibility conditions. However, he/she shall be exempted from the admission test.

IV HOW TO APPLY

- a) Candidates eligible as per eligibility requirements may fill in application forms online on <u>www.bangaloreuniversity.ac.in</u> or <u>www.ulcbangalore.com</u>
- b) Duly filled in applications along with self-attested relevant testimonials/documents in all respects must reach the Office of the Principal and Chairman, University Law College & Dept. of studies in Law. JnanaBharathi Campus, Bangalore University, Bengaluru-560 056, either in person or by post on or before the last date of submission.
- c) Entrance test question will be based on multiple choice questions for 100 marks (50 questions, each question carrying 2 marks)

ELIGIBILITY FEES

Indian Nationals who have passed the qualifying examination outside Karnataka shall pay the following *Eligibility Fees* to the University at the time of counseling in addition to the

regular fees.

Indian Nationals, Foreign Nationals and Non Resident Indians who have passed the qualifying examination abroad (outside India) shall submit the Equivalence Certificate issued by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) along with the application to the University. The provisional Eligibility certificate will be issued on payment of the prescribed fee. The provisional Eligibility certificate shall be obtained prior to admission.

REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEES (For the candidates who have paid the full Course fees)
